Longways duple minor improper

*Level of difficulty: Beginner*

- A    1 – 4    Couple two gate couple one down and around  
      5 – 8    Couple one cross & go below WHILE couple two waits  
              2 bars, then casts, finishing in a line of four with  
              couple one in the middle, facing up
- B1    1 – 4    Line of four up a double, fall back folding the line  
              to face partners , couple two now bove  
      5 – 8    All back-to-back partner
- B2    1 – 4    Couple one figure 8 up through couple two  
      5 – 8    In long lines (including any dancers out at the end),  
              fall back and come forward; drop current neighbour's  
              hand and keep next
