Square mixer

Level of difficulty: Intermediate

- A1 1 Sides set to partner WHILE the heads advance
2 Lines of 4 fall back (sides are facing partner, heads opposite)
3 – 4 2 hand turn (sides with partner, heads with opposite) end in same lines
- A2 1 – 2 Left hands across (in groups of 4) – ease out of the hands across and look for partner
3 – 4 Partner right hand turn – all end in square formation
- B1 1 Heads set to partner WHILE the sides advance
2 Lines of 4 at the sides fall back (heads are facing partner, sides opposite)
3 – 4 2 hand turn (sides with opposite, heads with partner)
- B2 1 – 2 Just the men left hands across WHILE the women cast back over their right shoulder one place
3 – 4 New partner right hand turn to men's home place
